Below are a few reminders regarding the championship meet. Please share this information with your parents, athletes, spectators, and other school personnel. - Team representatives and athletes may not arrive to Coatesville prior to 8:00AM on Friday.
- Coaches- please monitor your athletes and make sure they remain in the competition areas; No athletes, coaches, or spectators will be permitted in either building on campus.
  - No coaches or athletes will be permitted on the infield beyond the barriers (this area will be roped off)
  - o There is a warm-up area behind the home bleachers or the visiting sideline area nearest to the team tents for the next immediately scheduled event.
  - o Tents are not permitted to be set up near either school building on Friday, May 17
- District Championship Meet start times: Friday 10:00AM & Saturday 9:00AM
- All tickets per day are \$7.00 (plus processing fees) tickets must be purchased online only at the following link or the QR Scan below. Cash WILL NOT be accepted at the gate and no passes will be honored.

- Fire Police will be directing spectators where to park (no parking along curbs or on the grass unless directed) Green Lot, Red and Blue Lot for Spectators, and the Yellow Lot is reserved for PIAA representatives on a parking list and CASD Personnel / Disabled Parking specifically on Friday. Buses should plan to drop off on Friday and not remain on campus until after 2:30pm or to return for pick up only.

- Restrooms: 50 yard line on both sides and additional portable restrooms will also be available behind the home bleachers, at the throwing events near the shot and near the overflow parking areas

- Hydration stations will be set up at the 50 yard line at the home side on the infield and at the base of the bleachers on the team tent side bleachers. Athletes are asked to have their own refillable containers cups will also be available.

\*Please note the ATC tent will be located on the infield towards the finish line.


• AEDs are located with the ATC as well as the home concession stand in the stadium. A complete Emergency Action Plan is included with this communication.

Thank you in advance for your cooperation and the Coatesville Area School District is honored to once again to be able to host this year's Championship Meet. Good luck to all competitors and coaches!


