GENERAL INFORMATION

1. This district track meet is being held under the jurisdiction of the Board of Control, P. I. A. A. All contestants must meet P. I. A. A. eligibility rules. Events, conditions, etc., are governed by I. C. A. A. rules.

2. No school will be permitted more than three participants in any event with the exception of the relay race. In several instances it will be necessary for certain schools to "scratch" names from the printed program in order to comply with this rule.

3. No contestant may participate in more than three events. No contestant may participate in more than one track event longer than the 220. Participation in the mile relay race shall be counted as one of the track events longer than the 220.

4. No post entries, changes in entry lists, or substitutions will be allowed.

5. Six men will qualify for the finals in all events in which preliminaries are held with the exception of the 220-yard hurdles. In this event five men will qualify for the finals, the first two in each of the two semi-finals and the fastest third.

In the 440, 880, Mile, and Mile Relay only finals will be held. If there are too many contestants for one heat in these events, they will be run against time, each main place winner being timed.

6. No two contestants from one school will compete in the same trial heat. Positions from the pole will be drawn by the District Committee and will be handed to the Clerk of the Course. Semi-final heats will be run only if necessary.

7. To keep the field clear for spectators and to have the meet run under proper conditions, coaches and athletes not competing in events will keep away from the track during track events and from the field during field events. There will be ample room on the stands for all of these people.

8. The weight of the shot used in P. I. A. A. meets shall be 12 pounds. The discus and javelin shall conform to I. C. A. A. A. standards.

9. Five places will be scored in each event on a 5-4-3-2-1 basis. Gold, silver, and bronze medals will be awarded to the winners of first, second, and third places in each event. Trophies will be presented to the schools winning the highest total number of points in each class. Prizes will also be awarded to individuals scoring the highest total number of points in each class.

Medals and prizes will be distributed to winners from a stand erected at the south end of the field near the finish line.

10. The preliminaries will begin at 10.30 A. M. (Daylight Saving Time). Finals will begin at 2.00 P. M. The District Committee desires the meet to be run off without unnecessary delays. Contestants will therefore report promptly for their respective events.

11. The School Cafeteria will provide luncheons at a moderate charge for all athletes, coaches, officials, etc., that care to make use of this service.
