Swarthmore College gained its first major victory of the season over Haverford Saturday. Turned back on the baseball field and vanquished on the court, it fell to the lot of Bert Barron's trackmen to conquer their arch rivals, 81-45, in the annual dual meet at Swarthmore.

In routing Haverford for the third successive year, the victors carried off 10 first places and made clean sweeps in two fields. The only bright spot on the 16 event program for Haverford was Sturgis Footman's record-smashing high jump mark. The former Lower Merion High School athlete soared to a new meet record of 6 feet 2 inches.
