GENERAL INFORMATION

- This District Track Meet is being held under the jurisdiction of the Board of Control, P.I.A.A. All contestants must meet P.I.A.A. eligibility rules. Events, conditions, etc., are governed by N.C.A.A. rules.
- Class A schools are those whose total enrollment (boys and girls) in grades 9 to 12, inclusive, on October 1, 1948, was 500 or more; Class B schools are those with enrollments under 500 in the same grades on the same date.
- No school will be permitted more than three participants in any event with the exception of the relay race. In the 100-yard dash, the 220-yard dash, and the hurdle events, each school will be limited to two contestants in each event.
- No contestant may participate in more than three events.
- No post entries, changes in entry lists, or substitutions will be allowed.
- There shall be no semi-finals in track events. Trial heats will be necessary in certain events, but in the 440, 880, the mile, and both relays, only finals will be held. If there are too many contestants for one heat in these events, they will be run against time, each main place winner being timed.
- In the 200-yard low hurdles, the first hurdle shall be placed 18 yards from the start and the remaining hurdles at 18-yard intervals. The distance from the last hurdle to the finish shall be 20 yards.
- In the 120-yard high hurdles for Class A, 10 hurdles, 39 inches high, will be used. The first hurdle is 15 yards from the starting line. Each of the hurdles will be 10 yards apart, leaving 15 yards between the last hurdle and the finish.
- In the one-mile relay for Classes A and B, each contestant shall run one-quarter of the mile. In the half-mile relay, each contestant shall run 220 yards.
- The weights of the shot used in the P.I.A.A. meets shall be 12 pounds. The discus and javelin shall conform to N.C.A.A. standards.
- Five places will be scored in each event on a 5-4-3-2-1 basis. Gold, silver, and bronze medals will be awarded to the winners of first, second, and third places in each event. Trophies will be presented to the school winning the highest total number of points in each class. Medals and prizes will be distributed to winners from a stand erected on the field.
- The preliminaries will begin at 10:00 a.m. (daylight time). Finals will begin at 2:00 p.m. The District Committee desires the meet to be run off without unnecessary delays. Contestants will therefore report promptly for their respective events.
- To keep the field clear of spectators and to have the meet run under proper conditions, athletes not competing in events will keep away from the track during track events and from the field during field events. There will be ample room on the stands for all of these people.
- Coaches must remain in the stands.
- The price of admission to spectators is 50 cents, tax included.
- The State Championship Track and Field Meet will be held at State College on Saturday, May 27, 1950. The classification of schools and the rules for competition are the same as those governing the District Meets. Each of the twelve districts in the State may send two teams, Class A and Class B. Each team will be made up of two representatives in each event. The District Committee, in preparing the entry blank for the State Meet, will select the contestants that finish first and second in the various events unless notification is given by successful contestants that they cannot participate in the State Meet. In such cases the Committee will select winners of third, fourth, or fifth places in order. A relay team will be considered as a "representative" or "contestant."

GENERAL INFORMATION (continued)

- A drawing for places in track events and for order in field events has been made by the Committee before the meet.
- If an athlete is competing in the trials (100 or 220) he may pass his trials in broad or high jump (if entered) but he must report for these events within three minutes after completion of the sprints and remain at jumping pits.
- Athletes qualifying for the State Championship Meet will report to Mr. Zimmerman their decision concerning the trip. The District will collect \$9.00 from each athlete qualifying for and making the trip to the State Championship Meet at State College; the remainder of the cost will be borne by the District. Mr. Fishburn will act as official representative of the District Committee for the State Meet. No refund will be made for athletes traveling in private cars.
- In field events (shot, javelin, discus) every contestant will be allowed four throws in trials. The ten best performers will be given two more trials. The six best will qualify for the finals.
- The high jump starts at five feet. The bar will be raised by two-inch intervals to six feet; by one inch above six feet. Pole vault to start at nine feet. Bars to be raised by six-inch intervals to eleven feet; by three-inch intervals above eleven feet.
- Second place relay teams will be entered for the State Championship Meet but the District Committee will bear no further responsibility (financial or other) for transportation, housing or meals. This is due to the current economic situation.

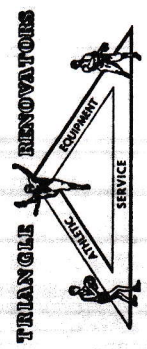

Delco Athletes Dominate

Capture 17 First Places at Norristown and Springfield Land 'A' and 'B' Laurels

Delaware County athletes captured 17 of the 29 first medals in the District I track championships at Upper Darby Saturday as Norristown retained its Class "A" team title. Springfield (Delco) dethroned Darby in Class "B."

The Delco performers produced four champions in Class "A" and took every first place in Class "B" except one 220-yard dash. As a result 25 county youngsters will make the trip to State College next Saturday for the PIAA championships.

In addition to the four Class "A" champions, there will be one runner-up. The Class "B" group, which includes both relay teams and one alternate for each, will be augmented by seven runners-up.

Individual stars of the meet among the county athletes were Chester's Don Frier, Darby's Charlie Wilson, and Swarthmore's F.F. Campbell.

Wilson came home with three Class "B" first-place medals. He won the 200-yard low hurdles and the broad jump and ran the third leg of Darby's winning half-mile relay team. His broad jump mark of 21 feet, 10 inches exceeded that of the Class "A" victor, Chester's B. Haverford, by more than seven inches.

Campbell Wins Two
Campbell was a double victor. He won the Class "B" shot put by almost three feet and took the discus by more than 12 feet. Second in both events was Springfield's Walt Schmidt, who also placed fifth in the shot put.

Frier lowered the Chester High School mile run record for the second straight week. Last week he cracked the 26-year-old standard for the first time in the Suburban Championships at Norristown with a 3:16.6 clocking. This week he was less than two seconds over the District mark with a brilliant 4:34.1, three and a half seconds under his Suburban time and 69 seconds below the record which stood from 1924 until this year.

Frier ran a heady race to triumph by four yards from Dave Mottshaw, of Springfield (Montco), runnerup for the second straight year. He ran his own race, letting Haverford's Bob Keiser and Haverford's Craig Ream set the pace, content to trail them by about six yards for the first two laps.

Midway through the four laps he took the lead briefly, only to have Keiser spurt ahead again. At the gun lap he trailed Keiser by two yards with Mottshaw six yards back.

Frier soon took the lead as the runners went into the last quarter
