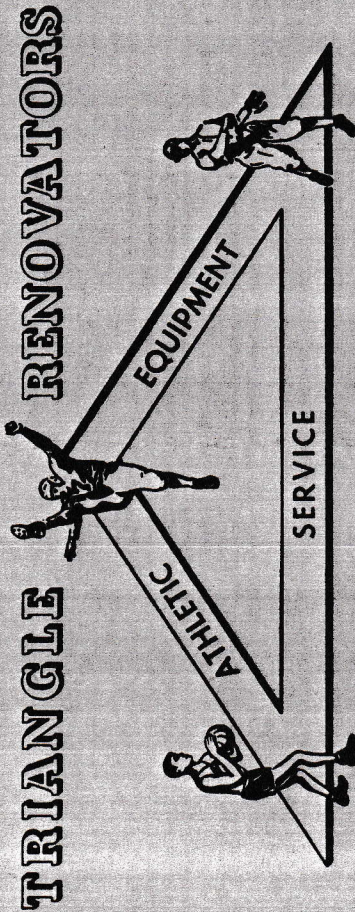

## GENERAL INFORMATION (continued)

17. A drawing for places in track events and for order in field events has been made by the Committee before the meet.
18. If an athlete is competing in the trials (100 or 220) he may pass his trials in broad or high jump (if entered) but he must report for these events *within three minutes* after completion of the sprints and remain at jumping pits.
19. Athletics qualifying for the State Championship Meet will report to Mr. Zimmerman their decision concerning the trip. The District will collect \$10.00 from each athlete qualifying for and making the trip to the State Championship Meet at State College; the remainder of the cost will be borne by the District. Mr. Fishburn will act as official representative of the District Committee for the State Meet. No refund will be made for athletes traveling in private cars.
20. In field events (shot, javelin, discus) every contestant will be allowed four throws in trials. The ten best performers will be given two more trials. The six best will qualify for the finals, with three final throws.
21. The high jump starts at five feet. The bar will be raised by two-inch intervals to six feet; by one inch above six feet. Pole vault to start at nine feet. Bars to be raised by six-inch intervals to ten feet; by three-inch intervals to eleven feet; by two-inch intervals above eleven feet.
22. Second place relay teams will be entered for the State Championship Meet but the District Committee will bear no further responsibility (financial or other) for the transportation, housing or meals.
23. Starting blocks shall be used when available.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

1. This District Track Meet is being held under the jurisdiction of the Board of Control, P.I.A.A. All contestants must meet P.I.A.A. eligibility rules. Events, conditions, etc., are governed by N.C.A.A. rules.
2. Class A schools are those whose total enrollment (boys and girls) in grades 9 to 12, inclusive, on October 1, 1951, was 500 or more; Class B schools are those with enrollments under 500 in the same grades on the same date.
3. No school will be permitted more than *three* participants in any event with the exception of the relay race. In the 100-yard dash, the 220-yard dash, and the hurdle events, each school will be limited to two contestants in each event.
4. No contestant may participate in more than *three* events.
5. No post entries, changes in entry lists, or substitutions will be allowed.
6. There shall be no semi-finals in track events. Trial heats will be necessary in certain events, but in the 440, 880, the mile, and both relays, only finals will be held. If there are too many contestants for one heat in these events, they will be run against time, each main place winner being timed.
7. In the 180-yard low hurdles, the first hurdle shall be placed 20 yards from the start and the remaining hurdles at 20-yard intervals. The distance from the last hurdle to the finish shall be 20 yards.
8. In the 120-yard high hurdles for Class A, 10 hurdles, 39 inches high, will be used. The first hurdle is 15 yards from the starting line. Each of the hurdles will be 10 yards apart, leaving 15 yards between the last hurdle and the finish.
9. In the one-mile relay for Classes A and B, each contestant shall run one-quarter of the mile. In the half-mile relay, each contestant shall run 220 yards.
10. The weights of the shot used in the P.I.A.A. meets shall be 12 pounds. The discus and javelin shall conform to N.C.A.A. standards.
11. Five places will be scored in each event on a 5-4-3-2-1 basis. Gold, silver, and bronze medals will be awarded to the winners of first, second, and third places in each event. Trophies will be presented to the school winning the highest total number of points in each class. Medals and prizes will be distributed to winners from a stand erected on the field.
12. The preliminaries will begin at 10:00 a.m. (daylight time). Finals will begin at 2:00 p.m. The District Committee desires the meet to be run off without unnecessary delays. Contestants will therefore report promptly for their respective events.
13. To keep the field clear of spectators and to have the meet run under proper conditions, athletes not competing in events will keep away from the track during track events and from the field during field events. There will be ample room on the stands for all of these people.
14. Coaches must remain in the stands.
15. The price of admission to spectators is 50 cents, plus city tax.
16. The State Championship Track and Field Meet will be held at State College on Saturday, May 26, 1951. The classification of schools and the rules for competition are the same as those governing the District Meets. Each of the twelve districts in the State may send two teams, Class A and Class B. Each team will be made up of two representatives in each event. The District Committee, in preparing the entry blank for the State Meet, will select the contestants that finish first and second in the various events unless notification is given by successful contestants that they cannot participate in the State Meet. In such cases the Committee will select winners of third, fourth, or fifth places in order. A relay team will be considered as a "representative" or "contestant."

# Simpson Shatters PIAA 440 Mark

Roland Simpson, of Cheltenham, considered one of the country's outstanding schoolboy runners, flashed to a new mark of 49.5 seconds in the 440 to set the only running record of five set as Coatesville (Class A) and Swarthmore (Class B) won team championships in the 26th annual District One, PIAA track and field meet yesterday at Franklin Field.

Simpson also completely dominated the anchor runners in the mile relay as he started in third place and brought Cheltenham the triumph in 3:31.2. In the 440 he was pressed for the first 220 by Lower Merion's Charles Ramsey but sprinted to the front and won by 20 yards. He cracked his own standard of 0:51.4 set last year.

#### 4 FIELD EVENT MARKS

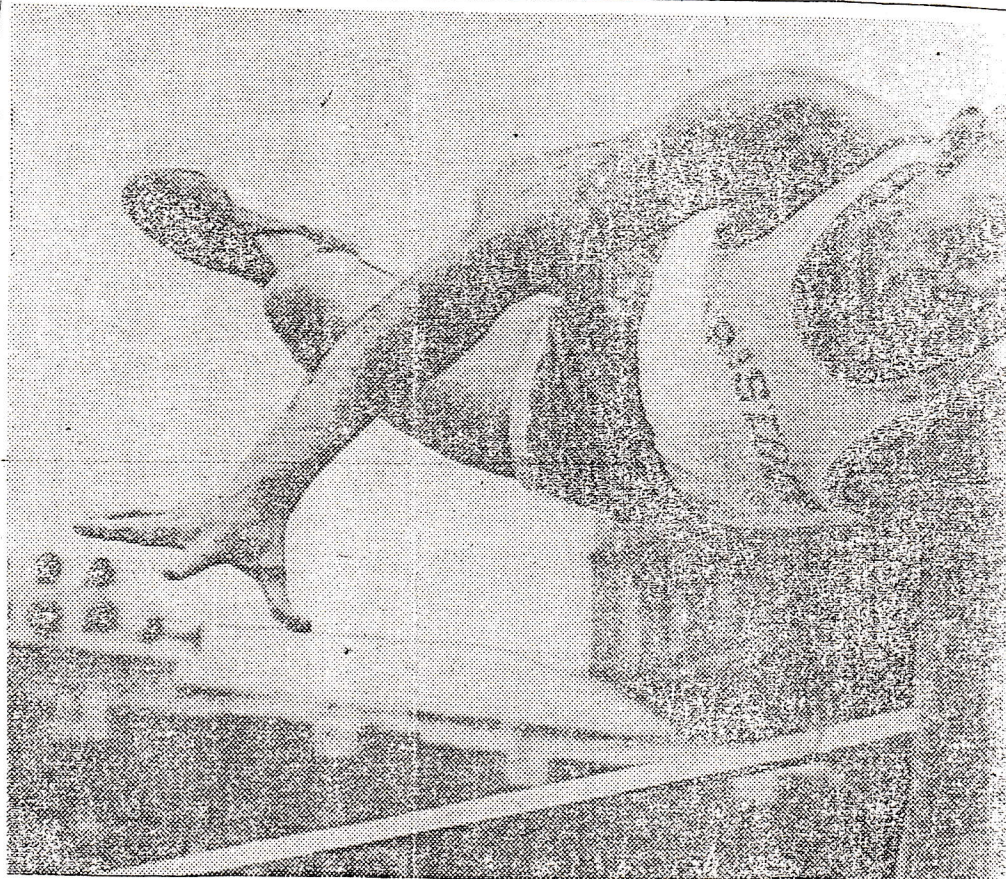
Burt Grossman, Lower Merion (shotput); Charles Blockson, Norristown (discus); Bob Barksdale, Norristown (high jump), and Jerry Baker, Ridley Park (Class B discus), set the other standards. Coatesville's Art Pollard, who unleashed a 0:09.7 century last week, equalled the District mark of 0:09.9 yesterday in the trials but was clocked at 0:10.1 as he won the final.

Coatesville completely outclassed its rivals in Class A with 50 1-7 points, while Norristown was second at 38 1-3 and Chester third with 31. In Class B Swarthmore repeated its 1951 achievement with 46 6-7 points to 32 1-4 for Darby and 22½ for Eddystone.

#### 15-YEAR RECORD

Barksdale cracked a 15-year-old standard in the high jump when he cleared the bar at six feet, 3¼ inches to break the mark set by Media's Bob Burnett in 1937 at 6-2. Baker cracked a Class B discus mark that has stood since 1945 when he tossed the plate 144 feet, five inches. The old mark was set by Doyles-town's Everett Fretz at 143 feet, 6¾ inches.

Grossman and Blockson each broke their own 1951 marks. Grossman tossed the shotput 58 feet, 2¾ inches against 56 feet, one inch in

Coatesville completely outclassed its rivals in Class A with 501-7 points, while Norristown was second at 381-3 and Chester third with 31. In Class B Swarthmore repeated its 1951 achievement with 466-7 points to 321-4 for Darby and 22½ for Eddystone.

### 15-YEAR RECORD

Barksdale cracked a 15-year-old standard in the high jump when he cleared the bar at six feet, ¾ inches to break the mark set by Media's Bob Burnett in 1937 at 6-2. Baker cracked a Class B discus mark that has stood since 1945 when he tossed the plate 144 feet, five inches. The old mark was set by Doylestown's Everett Fretz at 143 feet, 6¾ inches.

Grossman and Blockson each broke their own 1951 marks. Grossman tossed the shotput 58 feet, 2¾ inches against 56 feet, one inch in 1951, and is nearing the National record of 59 feet, 10 inches. Blockson's discus heave was 161 feet, 10½ inches last year.

Pollard's 0:09.9 time in the trials equalled his achievement of last year as well as the feats of Lansdowne's Fred Wetzel (1938), Upper Darby's Dick Ambrogi (1943) and Chester's Bennie Wright (1943).
