INFORMATION

A. General

1. This District Track and Field Championship Meet is being conducted by the District Committee under the jurisdiction of the Board of Control, P.I.A.A. All contestants must meet P.I.A.A. eligibility rules. Events, conditions, etc., are governed by the National Federation of High Schools' rules.
2. Class A schools are those whose total enrollments (boys and girls) in grades 10 to 12, inclusive, on October 31, 1961, were 500 or more; Class B schools are those with enrollments under 500 in the same grades on the same date.
3. Two participants per school is the maximum permitted in all events (except relays).
4. No contestant may participate in more than three events.
5. No post entries, changes in entry lists, or substitutions are allowed.
6. Five places will be scored in each event on a 5-4-3-2-1 basis. Gold, silver and bronze medals will be awarded to the winners of first, second, third, fourth and fifth places in each event. Trophies will be presented to the school winning the highest total number of points in each class. Medals and trophies will be distributed to winners from a stand erected on the field.
7. To keep the field clear of spectators and to have the meet run under proper conditions, athletes not competing in events will keep away from the track during track events and from field during field events. There will be room in the stands, and rest quarters, for these people.
8. Coaches must remain in the stands.
9. The price of admission to spectators is 75 cents, including a copy of this program.
10. Seeding for track events and the order of competition in field events were done before the Meet.
11. The State Championship Track and Field Meet will be held at Pennsylvania State University on Saturday, May 26, 1963. The classification of schools and the rules for competition are the same as those governing the District Meets. Each of the twelve districts in the Commonwealth may send two teams, Class A and Class B. Each team will be made up of two representatives in each event. In preparing the entry blank for the State Meet, the District Committee will select the contestants that finish first and second in the various events unless notification is given by successful contestants that they cannot participate in the State Meet. In such cases the Committee will select winners of third, fourth and fifth places in order. A relay team will be considered as a "representative" or "contestant." This procedure will be followed in making up both the Class A and Class B District teams.
12. Athletes qualifying for the State Championship Meet must be reported by their coaches to Mr. Lewis concerning their decision to take part in the State Meet IMMEDIATELY after the event. The costs of contestants to the State Meet will be borne by the District Committee. Mr. Lewis will be in charge of the District One teams on the trip and at the Meet. Mr. Fishburn will act as financial representative of the District Committee for the State Meet. Contestants may not travel to or from the State Meet in private cars without having obtained permission from Mr. Lewis. Such permission is required for athletes to be permitted to represent District One at the State Meet.
13. If an athlete is competing in the trials (100, 220, both hurdle races) he may pass his trials in field events (if entered) but he must report for these events within three minutes after completion of the trials and remain at the site of the field event(s).

B. Track Events

1. The preliminaries will begin at 10:00 A.M. (Daylight Time). Track finals will begin at 2:00 P.M. (Daylight Time). The District Committee desires the meet to be run off without unnecessary delays. Contestants will therefore report promptly for their respective events.
2. There will be no semi-finals in either track or field events. Trial heats will be necessary in certain events, but in the 440, 880, the mile, and both relays, only finals will be held. If there are too many contestants for one heat in these events, two or more heats will be run against time, each main place

- winner being timed. The first five place winners will be determined by their time performance.
3. In the 180-yard low hurdles, the first hurdle shall be placed 20 yards from the start and the remaining hurdles at 20-yard intervals. The distance from the last hurdle to the finish shall be 20 yards.
 4. In the 120-yard high hurdles, 10 hurdles, 39 inches high, will be used. The first hurdle is 15 yards from the starting line. Each of the hurdles will be 10 yards apart, leaving 15 yards between the last hurdle and the finish line.
 5. In all finals of running events, the times of both first and second places shall be taken and recorded.
 6. In the one-mile relays for Classes A and B, each contestant shall run one-quarter of the mile. In the half-mile relay, each contestant shall run 220 yards.
 7. Both first and second place relay teams in Class A and Class B will be taken to the State Meet by the District. Both first and second place relay teams, in Class A and Class B, will receive the same financial support from the District as any first and second place winners in other events.
 8. Claims for national records in sprint events and hurdles events will be accepted only when information about wind velocities can be furnished. A wind gauge will be used in these events in District meets. A wind velocity of less than 4.473 miles per hour favoring the runner is required for an application to receive favorable consideration.

C. Field Events

1. In the field events no entries are permitted after the first round.
2. In all field events, a contestant shall be charged with an unsuccessful attempt if he does not complete his trial or indicate his passing it, within TWO MINUTES after he had been called for a trial.
3. In the field events (shot, discus, javelin, running broad jump), every contestant will be allowed four trials. The six best will qualify for the finals with three trials each. Unless weather conditions warrant judges making changes, no discus throws of less than 120 feet; no javelin throws of less than 150 feet; no shot puts of less than 40 feet, will be flagged or measured. For District and State Championship Meets, in the event of ties in the jumping events, points will be divided. However, medal distribution and the contestants to go to the State Championship Meet, will be determined by the fewest misses. If two or more contestants have the same number of misses, the tie must be jumped off.
5. The weights of the shot used in P.I.A.A. meets shall be 12 pounds. The discus and javelin shall conform to N.C.A.A. standards. Shot and disci used in this meet are those belonging to the District Committee. Javelins must be weighed in and inspected before the event by the officials in charge of implement inspection.
6. At Norristown hard surfaces are used for jumping events, shot and discus throws, pole vault and broad jump. Rubber-soled shoes and rubber-soled shoes with pin spikes will be permitted—no others!
7. Coaches and winners in the shot put, discus throw, high jump, broad jump, pole vault, will note that at the State Championship Meet the surfaces will be hard surfaced. No spikes will be permitted on the shot and discus circles. Rubber-soled shoes must be used in these events.
8. The high jump will start at five feet, two inches. The bar will be raised by two-inch intervals to six feet; by one-inch intervals above six feet. Three misses at each height will disqualify.
9. The Class B pole vault will start at ten feet. The bar will be raised at six-inch intervals to eleven feet; by four-inch intervals above eleven feet; by two-inch intervals above twelve feet. Up to eleven feet, a total of three misses for all heights will disqualify a contestant. From eleven feet on, a total of three misses at any one height will disqualify a contestant.
10. The Class A pole vault will start at eleven feet. The bar will be raised at six-inch intervals to twelve feet; by two-inch intervals above twelve feet. Up to twelve feet, a total of three misses for all heights will disqualify a contestant. From twelve feet, on a total of three misses at any one height will disqualify a contestant.

Harriston, Downingtown Capture PIAA District One Track Titles

Despite the bad weather and a sloppy track, high school runners turned in respectable times as Harriston and Downingtown captured team titles in the District One track championships on the Norristown High course Saturday.

Harriston piled up 23 points on the strength of two firsts and three seconds. Downingtown accumulated 39 points with four firsts, two seconds, three thirds and a fourth.

Locals Mike Kahn, of West Chester, and Bruce Carter, of Pottstown, were standouts in the Class A competition, winning two events each.

The sole Class B double winner was Morrisville's Dave Holveck. The sloppy track put the damper on what may have been record-breaking runs.

Kahn's showing in the 220 with a 21.8 was exceptional for the condition of the track. Many of the coaches figured that a runner making a lap around the track added anywhere from a second to two seconds to his time because of the track.

Going by this measure, Kahn would have set a new standard in the 220-yard dash.

"The track's real bad," Mike said after qualifying. "The first 80 yards are real slow. It's just like a football field," the West Chester flash said with disappointment.

There was a big disappointment in the Pottstown camp, too.

State champion Bruce Carter was one of the double winners—but the sloppy track hampered him from setting any records in the 440 or 880. Carter took the 440 with a time of 51.2 and the 880 in 2:01.6.

"They were pretty good times but they were about a second or more over what they should have been because of the bad track," Ray Feich, assistant track coach at Pottstown High said.

"We had an injury that knocked us out of the championship this year. I'm sure that if Bill Jackowski hadn't hurt his leg we would have scored about six more points and that would have been

enough to win. "We didn't want to let Jackowski run at all. But he's a senior and he wanted badly to qualify for the state championships so we let him run in the mile.

"We're only going to run Bruce (Carter) in the 880 at the state championships this Saturday so that he'll have a better chance to set a record. We figured he has a good chance to set a new mark and we all would like to see him do it," the Pottstown coach concluded.

Ed Malinkowski, track coach at West Chester High which finished in a two-way tie for sixth place with 12 points, thought that the meet, as far as his team was concerned, was a big letdown all the way.

"I was extremely pleased with Mike Kahn's performance but there were some others that weren't up to par.

"Take Hagee for instance, our shot putter. He's been a good performer all year. He tries hard and he's come through with a lot of victories. But he didn't even place at the championships.

"In fact," the Warriors coach continued, "he's never had a good put over at Norristown.

"I figure that Kahn will have a good shot at the state record this Saturday if the weather holds up. Especially in the 220.

"If that track had been in good condition, I'm sure that he would have come real close to breaking Don Webster's record. Webster's mark is 21.2 and Mike came through with a 21.8 on that messy track.

"The boy Mike beat in both the 100 and 220 is a real fine runner. His name is Reggie Sydnor and he was runnerup to Webster in the state championships in 1961 in the 200 when Webster set his record.

"No matter what, I'm sure that Mike will make a good showing there Saturday," the West Chester coach concluded.

In all, 42 athletes qualified for the PIAA State championships which will be held at University Park this Saturday.

Coatesville High was another Ches-Mo school to be high in the final standings. Ross Kershey's Red Raiders finished in a tie for fourth place with 16 points. Dave Holveck was the out-

standing performer in the Class A 15.8 to set a new record in that B championships. He took first event since it was the first time the place in the 120-high hurdles with the event had been run the Dis-

trict One championships and he took first place in the 180-lap hurdles with a 21.3.

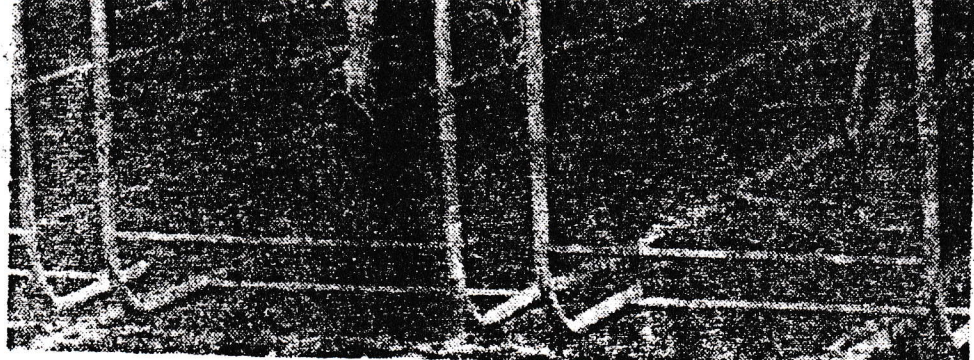
