

INFORMATION

A. General

- This District Track and Field Championship Meet is being conducted by the District Committee under the jurisdiction of the Board of Control, P.I.A.A. All contestants must meet P.I.A.A. eligibility rules. Events, conditions, etc., are governed by the National Federation of High Schools' rules.
- Class A schools are those whose total enrollments (boys and girls) in grades 10 to 12, inclusive, on October 31, 1962, were 500 or more; Class B schools are those with enrollments under 500 in the same grades on the same date. Beginning this year, entries to the District Meet must meet minimum qualifying standards. Coaches are held responsible for entering in events only those boys who have met or, in the reasoned judgment of the coach, will, on the day of the District Meet, be able to meet, these standards. Failure to adhere to or meet these standards could result in a school being barred from future meets.
- Should any boy whose name is not on the school entry list or in the program compete in any event; should any boy not named on the school entry list or in the program, use the name or number of a contestant whose name is in the program and school entry list and compete in an event:
 - all points scored in the meet by the school from which the boy who is in violation comes, shall be cancelled;
 - all medals won in the Meet by the school from which the boy who is in violation comes, shall be forfeited;
 - all entries from the school from which the boy who is in violation comes, for the State Meet, shall be disbanded;
 - the school from which the boy who is in violation comes, shall be disbanded from the District Meet the following year.
- Two participants per school is the maximum permitted in all events except the relays.
- No contestant may participate in more than three events.
- No post entries, changes in entry lists, or substitutions are allowed.
- Five places will be scored in each event on a 5-4-3-2-1 basis. Gold, silver and bronze medals will be awarded to the winners of first, second, third, fourth and fifth places in each event. Trophies will be presented to the school winning the highest total number of points in each class. Medals and trophies will be distributed to winners from a stand erected on the field. To keep the field clear of spectators and to have the meet run under proper conditions, athletes not competing in events will keep away from the track during track events and from field during field events. There will be room in the stands, and rest quarters, for these people.
- Coaches **MUST** remain in the stands.
- The price of admission to spectators is \$1.00, including a copy of this program.
- Seeding for track events and the order of competition in field events were done before the Meet.
- The State Championship Track and Field Meet will be held at Pennsylvania State University on Saturday, May 23, 1964. The classification of schools and the rules for competition are the same as those governing the District Meets. Each of the twelve districts in the Commonwealth may send two teams, Class A and Class B. Each team will be made up of two representatives in each event. In preparing the entry blank for the State Meet, the District Committee will select the contestants that finish first and second in the various events unless notification is given by successful contestants that they cannot participate in the State Meet. In such cases the Committee will select winners of third, fourth and fifth places in order. A relay team will be considered as a "representative" or "contestant." This procedure will be followed in making up both the Class A and Class B District teams. Athletes qualifying for the State Championship Meet must be reported by their coaches to Mr. Lewis concerning their decision to take part in the State Meet **IMMEDIATELY** after the event. The costs of contestants to the State Meet will be borne by the District Committee. Mr. Lewis will be in charge of the District One teams on the trip and at the Meet. Mr. Fishburn will act as financial representative of the District Committee for the State Meet. Contestants may not travel to or from the State Meet in private cars without having obtained permission from Mr. Lewis. Such permission is required for athletes to be permitted to represent District One at the State Meet.

INFORMATION (Continued)

- If an athlete is competing in the trials (100, 220, both hurdles races) he may pass his trials in field events (if entered) but he must report for these events within three minutes after completion of the trials and remain at the site of the field event(s).

- The preliminaries will begin at 10:00 A.M. (Daylight Time). Track finals will begin at 2:00 P.M. (Daylight Time). The District Committee desires the meet to be run off without unnecessary delays. Contestants will therefore report promptly for their respective events.
- There will be no semi-finals in either track or field events. Trial heats will be necessary in some events, but in the 440, 880, the mile, and both relays, only finals will be held. If there are too many contestants for one heat in these events, two or more heats, or sections, will be run against time, each main place winner being timed. The first five place winners will be determined by their time performance.
- In the 180-yard low hurdles, the first hurdle shall be placed 20 yards from the start and the remaining hurdles at 20-yard intervals. The distance from the last hurdle to the finish shall be 20 yards.
- In the 120-yard high hurdles, 10 hurdles, 39 inches high, will be used. The first hurdle is 15 yards from the starting line. Each of the hurdles will be 10 yards apart, leaving 15 yards between the last hurdle and the finish line.
- In all finals of running events, the time of both first and second places shall be taken and recorded.
- In the one-mile relays for Classes A and B, each contestant shall run one-quarter of the mile. In the half-mile relay, each contestant shall run 220 yards.
- Both first and second place relay teams in Class A and B will be taken to the State Meet by the District. Both first and second place relay teams, in Class A and Class B, will receive the same financial support from the District as any first and second place winners in other events.
- Claims for national records in sprint events and hurdles events, will be accepted only when information about wind velocities can be furnished. A wind gauge will be used in these events in District meets. A wind velocity of less than 4.473 miles per hour favoring the runner is required for an application to receive favorable consideration.

- In the field events, no entries are permitted after the first round.
- In all field events, a contestant shall be charged with an unsuccessful attempt if he does not complete his trial or indicate his passing it, within TWO MINUTES after he had been called for a trial.
- In the field events (shot, discus, javelin, running broad jump), every contestant will be allowed four trials. The six best will qualify for the finals with three trials each.

5. For District and State Championship Meets, in the event of ties, points and places will be decided according to Section 2, Rule 5, of the National Alliance Edition of Track and Field Rules.
6. The weights of the shot used in P.I.A.A. meets shall be 12 pounds. The discus and javelin shall conform to N.C.A.A. standards. Shot and disci used in this meet are those belonging to the District Committee. Javelins must be weighed in and inspected before the event by the officials in charge of implement inspection.
7. At Norristown, hard surfaces are used for jumping events, shot and discus throws, pole vault and broad jump. Rubber-soled shoes and rubber-soled shoes with pin spikes will be permitted—no others!
8. Coaches and winners in the shot put, discus throw, high jump, broad jump, pole vault, will note that at the State Championship Meet the surfaces will be hard surfaced. No spikes will be permitted on the shot and discus circles. Rubber-soled shoes must be used in these events.
9. The high jump starts at five feet four inches for Class B and five feet six inches for Class A. The bar will be raised by two-inch intervals to six feet; by one-inch intervals above six feet. Three misses at any one height will disqualify a contestant.
10. The Class B pole vault will start at ten feet. The bar will be raised by six-inch intervals to eleven feet; by four-inch intervals above eleven feet; by two-inch intervals above twelve feet. Up to eleven feet, a total of three misses for all heights will disqualify a contestant. From eleven feet on, a total of three misses at any one height will disqualify a contestant.
11. The Class A pole vault will start at eleven feet. The bar will be raised by six-inch intervals to twelve feet; by two-inch intervals above twelve feet. Up to twelve feet, a total of three misses for all heights will disqualify a contestant. From twelve feet, a total of three misses at any one height will disqualify a contestant.

Nicholas, Larson Lead Media to Track Crown

PIAA Dist. 1 Meet 5/16/1964 at Norristown HS, Roosevelt Field

NORRISTOWN—Julius Nicholas, a newcomer to fame and glory, and Larry Larson, a veteran, combined to pace Media to the Class B championship at Track and Field Championships here Saturday.

Nicholas, relatively unknown until he won in the Suburbans last week, swept home first in both the 120 high hurdles and 180 lows, tying a meet record in the former in 15.8.

Larson, probably the county's finest sprinter this year, barreled two wins in the 100 and 220, and anchored Media's 880 relay team home firsts.

Those five firsts, powered the Mustangs to the Class B title with 34 points. Ridley Park was second with 29, followed by Swarthmore with 28 and Darby-Colwyn 27.

It was Media's second B championship in three years.

Abington, sparked by Bill Bryant's triple, took the A team title with 41 points.

No Delaware County team placed in the top five in Class A.

Upper Darby finishing highest with a sixth place tie with eight points.

The Royals' Bill Edgar was one of three county winners in Class A, copping the 120 high hurdles.

Interboro's Vince Papale won the pole vault, and Lansdowne-Aldan's Greg Ellis landed the shot put blue ribbon.

The first two in each event qualified for the state championships next Saturday at Penn State's University Park.

In Class B, Swarthmore's Doug Tolley won a double, finishing first in the 440 and mile, while teammate Tyler Parsons won the 880.

Other county winners were: Sharon Hill's Frank Rock in the pole vault, Darby's Wayne Trent in the broad jump; Ridley Park's Greg Campbell in the high jump; and Darby's Scott Kinard in the shot put.

Two meet records were broken. Pottstown's Frank Lacey set a new mile mark in Class A with a 4:27.3, while Woodrow

Wilson's Gary Steele established a high jump standard in the same division with 6-5/4.
