## INFORMATION

### A. GENERAL

1. The District Track and Field Championship Meet is being conducted by the District Committee under the auspices of the Board of Control, P.I.A.A. All contestants must meet P.I.A.A. eligibility rules. Events, conditions, etc., are governed by the National Federation of State High School Athletic Association rules, with such variations as have been established by the P.I.A.A. Board of Control, and the Official P.I.A.A. Rules and Regulations Governing Inter-scholastic Sports Competition.
2. Class A schools are those whose total enrollment (boys and girls) in grades 10 to 12, inclusive, on October 31, 1970, were 800 or more. Class B schools are those with enrollments under 500 in the same grades on the same date.
3. Participants in the District Meet must meet published minimum qualifying standards. Only those boys will compete in this meet whose names have been submitted on "Participants Forms" on the basis of having met the minimum qualifying standards in prior meets. Continued failure to meet these standards will result in the District Committee being requested to bar the offending school(s) from the District Meet. No boy may be listed on the "Participants Form" whose name was not on the original entry list.
4. Should any boy whose name is not on the school entry list, reproduced in this program, and on the "Participants Form" compete in any event; should any boy not named on this school entry list and program and "Participants Form," use the name or number of a contestant does appear as above, and compete in any event:
  - a) all points scored in the meet by the school from which the boy who is in violation comes, may be forfeited;
  - b) all medals won in the meet by the school from which the boy who is in violation comes, may be forfeited;
  - c) all entries from the school from which the boy who is in violation comes, may be disbarred from the State Meet;
  - d) the school from which the boy who is in violation comes, may be disbarred from the District Meet the following year.
5. Two participants per school is the maximum permitted in all events except the relay races in which only one relay team per school in each relay event is permitted.
6. No contestant may participate in more than three events, exclusive of the two-mile run. Participants in the two-mile run may not participate in any other event.
7. Participants in three events or in the two-mile run may not be named as alternates to a relay team for the State Meet on which he did not run in the District Meet.
8. No post entries, changes in entry lists or "Participants Forms," or substitutes are allowed.
9. Five places will be scored in each event on a 6-4-3-2-1 basis. Medals will be awarded to first, second, third, fourth and fifth places in each event. Trophies will be awarded to the schools winning the highest total number of points, one to each class. Medals and trophies will be distributed to the winner immediately after each event and at the end of the meet.
10. Seeding for track events and the order of competition in field events were done before the meet.
11. To keep the field clear of spectators and to have the meet run under proper conditions, coaches will instruct athletes not competing in events to keep away from the track during track events and from the field events area.
12. Coaches MUST remain in the stands unless called for.
13. The price of admission to spectators is \$1.00 including a copy of this program. Tickets purchased Friday will be good for the Saturday portion of the meet.
14. The P.I.A.A. Championship Track and Field Meet will be held at Pennsylvania State University on Friday and Saturday, May 26 and 27, 1972. The classification of schools and the rules for competition are the same as those governing the District Meet. Each of the twelve districts in the P.I.A.A. may send two teams, one Class A and one Class B. Each team will be made up of three representatives in each event. In preparing the entry blank for the State Meet, the District Committee will select contestants who finished first, second and third in the various events. When notification is given by qualifying con-

- testants that they will or can not compete in the State Meet, the District Committee will select winners of fourth and fifth places in order.
15. A relay team will be considered as a "representative" or "contestant." One alternate member may be added to each relay team qualifying for the State Meet and any four of the five members listed for a relay team may run at the State Meet. (See No. 3 for limitations). No other contestant may be substituted for any of the five boys listed for a particular relay team.
  16. Athletes who qualify for the State Meet must be reported by their coaches to Mr. Kauler, Track Chairman and the Chief Scorer IMMEDIATELY after the event in which they qualify, whether or not they will compete in the State Meet.
  17. Should any qualifier for the State Meet not wish to compete in a particular event for which he is qualified, notice to that effect MUST be given to Mr. Kauler and the Chief Scorer before the end of the District Meet. Without such notice, all qualifiers for the State Meet must compete in all of the events for which he qualified. Otherwise, he will be scratched in all events for which he qualified.
  18. The costs of contestants to the State Meet will be borne by the District Committee. Track Chairman Kauler, with his members of the Track Steering Committee, will be in charge of the District One teams at the State Meet.
  19. If an athlete is competing in a track event scheduled during the time he is competing in a field event, he may request and be excused by the field judge to compete in the track event. He must be back within ten minutes in order to complete his trials and must have reported back for his remaining trials before the completion of the trials and the start of the finals. Coaches will instruct contestants to report to the field judge for excusal to compete in the track event.
  20. In all competition for both track and field events, jerseys must be worn inside the trunks. No caps, tams, necklaces or head bands may be worn. All members of a relay team must wear the similar uniforms. All contestants will wear shoes on both feet.
- ### B. TRACK EVENTS
1. An individual or relay team becomes a contestant or participant when he reports to the Clerks of the Course.
  2. On Friday, May 19, 1972:
    - a) Trials will be conducted for CLASS A contestants in the 100-yard dash 180-yard low hurdles 220-yard dash
    - b) Finals will be conducted in the Class B pole vault
    - c) Finals will be conducted for Class A and Class B in the 330-yard intermediate hurdles
  3. On Saturday, May 20, 1972, semi-finals (for Class A) and trials (for Class B) will begin at 9:30 A.M., in the events listed under 2(a) above.
  4. In the 440-yard dash, 880-yard run, one- and two-mile runs, the three relay events, only finals will be held. When there are too many contestants for one final in these events, two or more sections will be run against time, each main place winner being timed. The first five places will be determined on time performance.
  5. In cases of ties, duplicate medals will be awarded. Ties for third place must be decided to determine the third place entry to the State Meet. This will be done by a run-off of the tie not later than one hour after the last running event with the option that a toss of a coin shall decide the tie if one of the coaches concerned requests that method be used.
  6. In all finals of running events, the times of no less than first, second, third and fourth places shall be taken and recorded.
  7. Claims for national and district records in sprints and hurdles events will be accepted only when information about wind velocities can be furnished. A wind gauge will be used in these events in District Meets. A wind velocity of less than 4.473 miles per hour favoring the runner is required for an application to receive favorable consideration.
  8. At both the District and State Meets, the 220-yard dash will be run around one curve.

## INFORMATION (Continued)

9. In the Friday trials in the hurdles and sprints, if there are:
  - a) six heats, the first three places qualify for the semi-finals, first and second places from each of those qualifying for the final;
  - b) five heats, the first three places qualify for 3 semi-finals of five each, first and second places from each qualifying for the final;
  - c) four heats, first three places from each qualifying for two semi-finals, with the first three places qualifying for the final.
 The only spikes permitted on the North Penn track and runways will be not over one-quarter inch, non hex-head type.

### C. FIELD EVENTS

1. An individual becomes a participant when he reports to the field judge. No entries will be permitted after the field judge starts a competition.
2. In all field events, a contestant shall be charged with an unsuccessful attempt if he does not complete his trial or indicates his passing it, within two minutes after he has been called for a trial.
3. In the discus throw, javelin throw, shot put, long jump and triple jump, every contestant will be allowed three trials. Immediately afterward, the six best performers will qualify for the finals and shall have three more trials.
4. In cases of ties, Section 2, Rule 6, National Alliance Edition Rules shall be used to resolve them. Ties unresolved by this method shall result in splitting of points and duplicate medals being awarded.
5. Where ties for third place result after the application of Section 2, Rule 6, a toss of a coin by the Head Field Judge shall determine the contestant to compete in the State Meet.
6. The weight of the shot used in P.I.A.A. Meets shall be twelve pounds. The discus and javelin shall conform to NCAA standards. Javelins must be weighed in and inspected before the event by the officials in charge of implementations. Shot and disci used in the District Meet shall be those belonging to the District Committee.
7. At North Penn, concrete surfaces are used for the discus and shot put circles. Flat-soled shoes are required for these events. There are no spike or shoes requirements for the javelin throw.
8. At North Penn, all jumping surfaces are of the same composition as the track. Only spikes not over one-quarter inch, non hex-head may be used.
9. Coaches and competitors in the State Meet will note that in all field events except the javelin, the surfaces will be hard-surfaced. No spikes will be permitted on the shot and discus circles. Flat-soled shoes will be worn for these events. The running track, jumping areas require the use of spikes no longer than one-quarter inch, non hex-head type.
10. At the State Meet, the shot and disci for competition will be furnished by the P.I.A.A. School-owned implements may be used only for practice.
11. In the high jump the distances on interval raises will be decided by the Track Steering Committee prior to the District Meet. A total of three consecutive misses shall disqualify a contestant.
12. In the pole vault, the distance of interval raises will be decided by the Track Steering Committee prior to the District Meet. A total of three consecutive misses shall disqualify a contestant.
13. If weather conditions on the day of the District Meet require it, the Track Steering Committee will rule on the starting height and interval raises to be used in the pole vault and high jump.
14. Contestants entered in track and field events that are running at the same time, see Item No. 18 under General Information on how to handle this problem.

### D. COACHES

1. Coaches and contestants, as instructed by coaches, are urgently requested to cooperate in reducing congestion on the track and infield. This includes team managers not being admitted to the field or track to run sweat suits and limiting camera privileges on the track and infield to official press photographers only.
2. The prompt, efficient cooperation of all boys and officials and coaches is required in order to adhere to the time schedule. If the meet runs faster than the time schedule, no delays will be set up merely to adhere to the schedule. Each event will be run as soon as the preceding one is finished, exclusive of the time between events 29 and 1. However, running events in the afternoon will not be permitted to run more than 10 minutes ahead of schedule.

# Moser Raises Tennent Hopes

William Tennent High School was expecting a state track champion this year.

These hopes, nearly snuffed out this week when Penn-bound half-miler Ken Ashworth pulled up lame, soared yesterday when Randy Moser, running the 330 intermediate hurdles for only the second time competitively, swept to the PIAA District One Class A title in 39.5 on North Penn's wet track.

Coach Ken Montgomery was still mourning the loss of Ashworth, who ran a 1:56.1 outdoor 880 in March—best in the area—and went 1:54.1 against Lawrenceville this winter to rank number one in the nation indoors.

"It's a bitter pill," said Montgomery. "He's been working four years for this. He was very obviously the favorite in the district and in the state.

"It happened in our last practice for this meet. One interval too many, I guess. The doctor diagnosed it as a groin pull and said that unless Kenny rests it completely, it could be a permanent problem.

## Kieffer Lame

"Pulls like this usually happen to sprinters, not distance men. We were doing pace work. With the weather, he hasn't run any good times this spring and we were counting on these last few weeks to break loose."

Stan Kieffer, who joined Ashworth and Moser on Tennent's mile relay quartet that upset Norristown in 3:20.5 at the Penn Relays, pulled up lame in last Saturday's Suburban One championships.

Spts PIAA Track add one "You can't cry over spilled milk now," said Montgomery.

If Moser wins a PIAA title next weekend at Penn State, it won't count in the team standings. Starting next spring, the PIAA will replace the 180 low hurdles with the 330. For now, both events are being run, the lows counting in the standings.

"Call it a non-scoring event if you want, but it gets you to the state meet and makes you a state champion," Montgomery said.

Moser has run a 50.8 440 out of the blocks and 49.0 relay anchor leg.

"With his 440 background, the 330 hurdles are a natural," the coach said. "He's still trying to run against people, catch them on the stagger. You can't do that. The hurdles are a rhythmic event."

## Mondschein 2d

Haverford's Brian Mondschein, recovering from torn ankle ligaments that kept him out of the pole vault for a month until Tuesday (he cleared 13-6), was second in the intermediate hurdles, winning his heat (final placings on time), in 39.7.

Lower Moreland's Chris Beechwood won the Class B intermediates (41.4).

Walt Crump, who was too sick to go to his senior prom Friday night, and Jim Morrison, who won't attend his senior prom this Friday, wiped Pennsylvania Interscholastic Athletic Association District One's oldest track records off the books yesterday.
Crump, who also anchored Darby Township High to a record 1:30.3 in the Class B relay and then tied the 220-yard curve mark with a 22.9 opened his three-triumph day by blazing a 9.7 100 - erasing the 10.0 standard first set by Sellersville-Perkasie's Harry Gutekunst in 1934.
Morrison, who warmed up by defending his Class A mile title in a record 4:16.4, then powered to a 1:54.8 clocking in the half-mile, 2.3 seconds under the performance of Upper Darby's Richard Belyea that has stood up since 1938.
Adlam Again
Abington junior Jim Adlam provided the outstanding field event performance, pole vaulting 15-6 - 14 inches above Mark Mondschein's district record and 15 1/2 above Mondschein's state meet mark.
"Now I know Tuesday (state record 15-9) wasn't just luck," said Adlam, who had doubts when he missed his first tries at 12-6, 13-0, and 12-6.
Also setting Class A meet records were: Springfield Delco's Pete Van Ingen, 9:18.8 two-mile; Norristown's Ronnie Livers, 46-1 1/2 triple jump; Pennsbury's Mark Dahman, 22.2 220 (curve); Norristown's 1:29.0 880 relay and, Wissahickon's 3:18.8 and 7:51.0 in the mile and two-mile relays.
Darby Twp.'s Alvin Arnold, who joined Crump on the school's record-setting 880 relay, tied a mark with a 50.3 Class B 440. Besides Crump, Class B had two more triple winners: Oxford's Chuck Peterson (High, long, and triple jumps), and Lower Moreland's John Reinhardt (mile and two-mile relays, 880).

When Crump reported to coach Aonzo Covert yesterday morning, he claimed he was too sick to run.
"I had a sore throat, a was hard to breathe," said headache, and 101 fever. It Walt, whose 9.7 was 0.9 seconds faster than the second-place finisher. "The prom was last night (at the Bellevue-Stratford), but I stayed home. I was very disappointed.
"I'm still sick, but I had to make it to the states, so I pushed myself."
"All I gave him was two aspirins and some cough syrup," said Covert. "If somebody pushes him, he could run a 9.6 or a 9.5."
Morrison, who had no opposition in the second lap of the 880, was 25 yards behind and in fifth place, 220 yards into the race.
"Those guys went out too fast," said the Pennsbury star, who is deciding between offers from Florida, Penn State, and Rice. "That wasn't too bright, but it helped me. It made me push myself on the first quarter."
District Champ
Morrison won the district mile a year ago but was fifth in the 880.
"Last year I couldn't come back. Now I'm much stronger. My kick in the mile (62-second final quarter) helped me in the 880. I like to run a race before. It warms you up."
Morrison might be stronger, but he won't attempt to go to Pennsbury's prom this Friday.
"I didn't even bother getting a date. You might say I was confident of making it to the states."
Keep His Date
Van Ingen's 9.18.8 was 4.3 seconds lower than the existing state meet record -- but he has no plans to break his date for Springfield's senior prom Friday.
"If I don't do well Saturday, you'll know why," grinned the Maryland-bound star. "But I still think I'll do all right. I'll catch some sleep on the way up to Penn State, and then the adrenalin will be flowing."

Walt Crump, who was too sick to go to his senior prom Friday night, and Jim Morrison, who won't attend his senior prom this Friday, wiped Pennsylvania Interscholastic Athletic Association District One's oldest track records off the books yesterday.
Crump, who also anchored Darby Township High to a record 1:30.3 in the Class B relay and then tied the 220-yard curve mark with a 22.9 opened his three-triumph day by blazing a 9.7 100 — erasing the 10.0 standard first set by Sellersville-Perkasie's Harry Gutekunst in 1934.
Morrison, who warmed up by defending his Class A mile title in a record 4:16.4, then powered to a 1:54.8 clocking in the half-mile, 2.3 seconds under the performance of Upper Darby's Richard Belyea that has stood up since 1938.
Adlam Again
Abington junior Jim Adlam provided the outstanding field event performance, pole vaulting 15-6 — 14 inches above Mark Mondeschein's district record and 15 1/2 above Mondeschein's state meet mark.
"Now I know Tuesday (state record 15-9) wasn't just luck," said Adlam, who had doubts when he missed his first tries at 12-6, 13-0, and 12-8.
Also setting Class A meet records were: Springfield Delco's Pete Van Ingen, 9:18.8 two-mile; Norristown's Ronnie Livers, 46-1 1/2 triple jump; Pennsbury's Mark Dahlman, 22.2 220 (curve); Norristown's 1:29.0 880 relay and, Wissahickon's 3:18.8 and 7:51.0 in the mile and two-mile relays.
Darby Twp.'s Alvin Arnold, who joined Crump on the school's record-setting 880 relay, tied a mark with a 50.3 Class B 440. Besides Crump, Class B had two more triple winners: Oxford's Chuck Peterson (High, long, and triple jumps), and Lower Moreland's John Reinhardt (mile and two-mile relays, 880).

100 Sick to Run

When Crump reported to coach Aonzo Covert yesterday morning, he claimed he was too sick to run.
"I had a sore throat, a was hard to breathe," said headache, and 101 fever. It Walt, whose 9.7 was 0.9 seconds faster than the second-place finisher. "The prom was last night (at the Bellevue-Stratford). but I stayed home. I was very disappointed.
"I'm still sick, but I had to make it to the states, so I pushed myself."
"All I gave him was two aspirins and some cough syrup," said Covert. "If somebody pushes him, he could run a 9.6 or a 9.5."
Morrison, who had no opposition in the second lap of the 880, was 25 yards behind and in fifth place, 220 yards into the race.
"Those guys went out too fast," said the Pennsbury star, who is deciding between offers from Florida, Penn State, and Rice. "That wasn't too bright, but it helped me. It made me push myself on the first quarter."
District Champ
Morrison won the district mile a year ago but was fifth in the 880.
"Last year I couldn't come back. Now I'm much stronger. My kick in the mile (62-second final quarter) helped me in the 880. I like to run a race before. It warms you up."
Morrison might be stronger, but he won't attempt to go to Pennsbury's prom this Friday.
"I didn't even bother getting a date. You might say I was confident of making it to the states."
Keep His Date
Van Ingen's 9.18.8 was 4.3 seconds lower than the existing state meet record -- but he has no plans to break his date for Springfield's senior prom Friday.
"If I don't do well Saturday, you'll know why," grinned the Maryland-bound star. "But I still think I'll do all right. I'll catch some sleep on the way up to Penn State, and then the adrenalin will be flowing."
