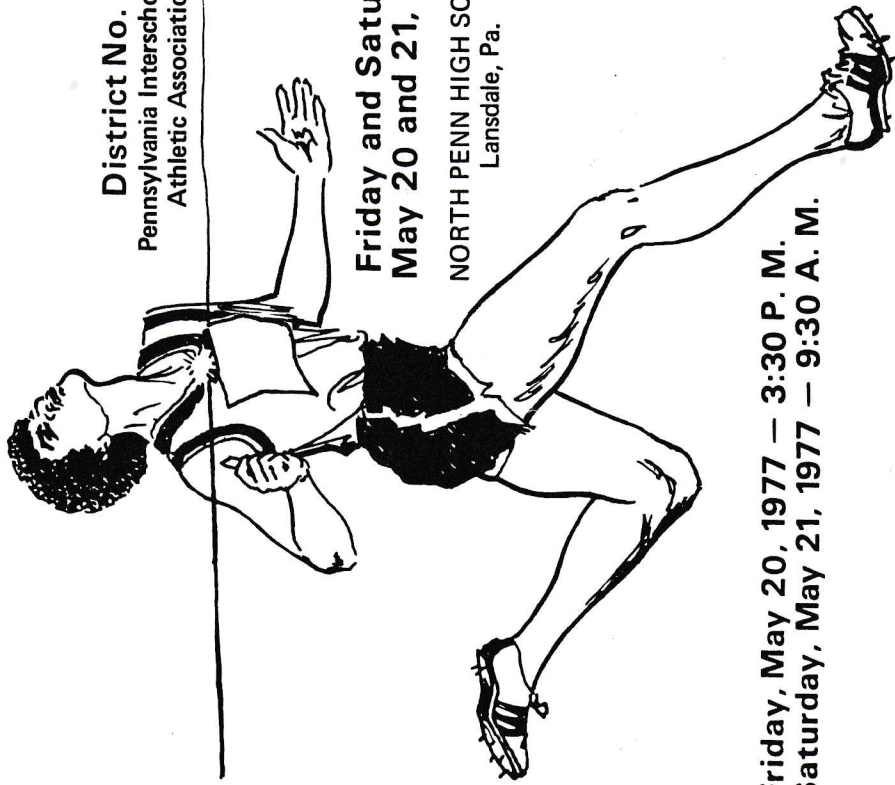

Coatesville takes AAA track

The Coatesville Red Raiders used good depth and balance to capture AAA honors in the 53rd PIAA District One Track and Field Championships at North Penn High School Saturday afternoon.

Victories in the two mile relay, the 440 and the mile relay led the way as the Raider thinclads remained undefeated for the season.

"We were optimistic going into this meet, but made no predictions," said a happy and pleased coach Harry Lewis. Commenting on the balance shown by his squad, he added, "We depended on everyone and they all made contributions."

The Raiders have many seniors on the team and aside from concentrating on a District One title, Lewis wanted to get as many of his athletes into the State Championship meet this Friday and Saturday at Shippensburg State College, as possible. The amiable Coatesville coach was successful on both counts as he arranged his relay teams to allow the maximum number of runners the chance to participate.

The results had to gratify Lewis, since in this, his third year as head coach, he has a team that he has personally built.

The Raiders gained their first victory in the two-mile relay as Steve Hunter, Brinton Myers, Bill Boynes and Sol Hunter led all the way to win easily in the time of 7:58.26. Chester was second more than three seconds behind the winners.

Greg Ellis captured honors in the 440, circling the oval in 49.98. He was tested by Dave Foss, who finished second in 50.10. Willie Alston of the Raiders was fifth in the race. Downingtown's Bill Wright took fourth.

Coatesville clinched its victory by winning the mile relay. Pennsbury, which finished second in the race, was also the

runner up in the meet. The team, consisting of Myers, Boynes, Willie Alston and Ellis, turned in a very creditable 3:21.0, while Pennsbury finished in 3:22.64. Henderson finished fifth in 3:24.30.

Coatesville gets cup

The victory in the mile relay gave the Raiders the added distinction of being the first team to capture the Charles Otto Roesser Cup. This new award, named after the popular veteran official, who had devoted his life to sports on all levels from high school to professional, will be given annually to winners of the mile relay event in men's and women's competition on both the AAA and AA levels.

"We are very pleased to be the first team to win this award," said Lewis. Aside from the excellent showing made Saturday, Coatesville has also won the Ches-Mont Championship meet, the Chester County Relays, and gone 11-0 in dual meet competition, defeating 10 Ches-Mont rivals and Chester High.

Sterling Saunders of West Chester East took the top spot in the javelin throw with a toss of 199-6. Bill Boynes of Coatesville was second at 196-9 inches.

Saunders, a senior, was consistent on his throws, with the winning effort coming on his second try. "I had to work hard to win today," he said. "This is my best throw so far." Saunders feels a distance of 210 feet is within his capabilities.

Bill Wesley, a junior at Henderson, took first place in the long jump with a leap of 22-3. Wesley had a jump earlier this season of 23-9 in the Chester County Relays, a distance equal to the AAA record for the State Championship meet set in 1963 by Ron Coleman of Grove City. The AA record in the State meet is held by Russell Dickinson of Octorara, who leaped 24-3½ last year.

"I hope to do 25 feet before graduation next year," said Wesley. He is looking forward to the State meet. "I'll do my

best," he said when asked for a prediction on how he will fare at Shippensburg. Bill Dorsey of Coatesville took the fourth spot in the event jumping 21-4¾.

In an excellent and exciting 880 race, Conestoga's Joe Beck edged Coatesville's Sol Hunter. The Pioneer runner hit the tape in 1:55.43 to Hunter's 1:56.34. The two battled the entire distance with Beck beating off a strong challenge by the Raider runner down the stretch.

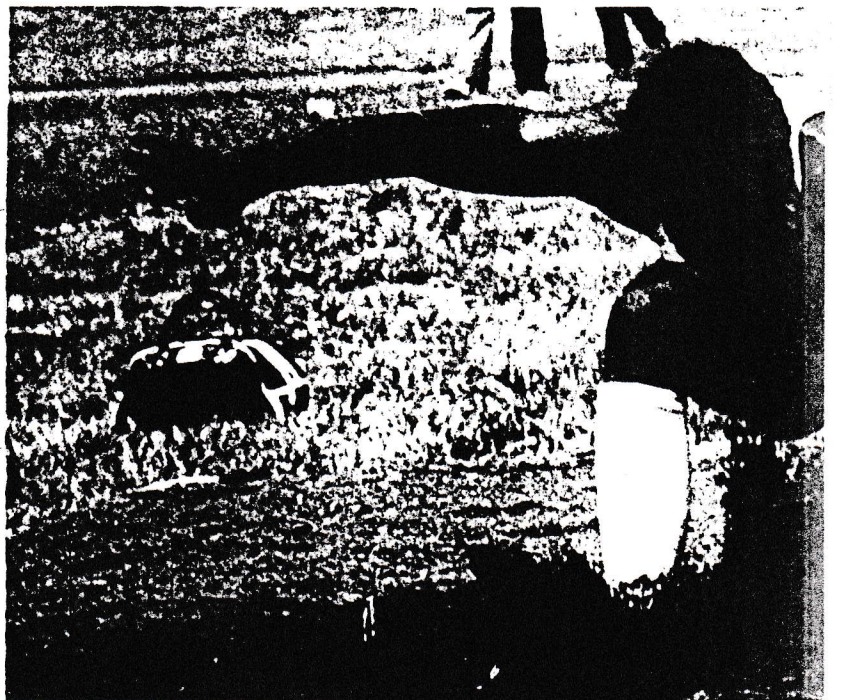

The only other first taken by an athlete representing the SCCL was by Chris Pollock of Oxford, who won the discus throw with a heave of 134-6. Gary Baker of Octorara finished fourth in the discus competition with a toss of 121-3.

The battle for first place in the long jump was very close. Garnet Valley's Larry Kinney took first with a leap of 20-5¼. Alvin Pettigrew of Northern Chester County Tech finished fourth, jumping 20-1.

Kinney also took first place in the triple jump, leaping 44-10. John McMillan of Avon Grove placed third in that event, covering a distance of 41-10¼.

Coatesville squad proves it's best of the balanced

Lloyd Bingham, Coatesville High's personable young track coach, looked around the nearly deserted North Penn football stadium late yesterday afternoon and reflected on the District One track season.

"This was the most balanced meet in a few years," Lewis said. "There were no superstars, no really outstanding individuals. Even on our team, the victory was a tribute to team work because so many contributed."

Lewis was clutching the Class AAA team championship trophy, symbolic of the best-balanced team in the best-balanced district meet in memory. Coatesville, lacking the brilliance or dominance of a single superstar, put together 60 points with relay teams and some strong individual showings,

That clinched the meet and consigned a consistent Pennsbury team to second place, with 52 points. Chester's 45 points were good for third. In the Class AA competition, Darby Township and Perkiomen Valley staged a day-long alley fight, before Darby Township got 10 points by winning the mile relay, an event in which Perkiomen Valley did not place.

That gave Darby Township 85½ points to 83 for Perkiomen Valley. No

other team was anywhere near that great duo. St. Pius X of Pottstown was third with 54, edging Garnet Valley, which scored 52½ points.

Coatesville regained a title it last won in 1973, Ross Kershey's final year as head coach.

"About midway during the indoor season we realized we had a chance to win it all," Lewis said. "All these kids were with us in indoors and most of them had been in cross country. So we had an inkling in December... we knew we had a team to beat."

"We didn't know for sure," pointed out assistant Tom Ingram. "We knew Sol and Ellis could win, but we didn't know if they would. Plus, we got a lot of points on fifth and sixth places. When you win by eight points, those ones and twos add up."

If anything, Coatesville's victory was smaller than it might have been, since Lewis said he had a few disappointments in the long and triple jumps, and his high jumper was injured.

The high jump probably the biggest surprise of the meet, when Ray Ploucher of William Tennent cranked up the best effort of his career, 6 feet 9 inches, to upset defending champion Chris Bercton of Bensalem. Bercton, the PIAA record holder with 7-0, managed to jump only 6-8 and was so stunned he forgot to pick up his second-place medal.

Another defending champion, miler Jim Van Blunk of Pennsbury, ran third in his specialty, but came back to win the two mile in 9:32.54.

Top individual performances included a 200-foot, 4-inch javelin throw by Perkiomen Valley's Bill Neill. That stands as the best in the area this spring.

A 14-2 pole vault by Dave Scott of Central Bucks East and a 1:55.43 in the 800 by Joe Beck of Conestoga followed.
