

# Penn Wood girls, W. C. Henderson

## Grube not enough for Upper Darby

It was a typically hectic day for Upper Darby's Rebecca Grube, whom one rival coach termed the "finest all-round girls' athlete I've ever seen."

The junior won the 300-meter hurdles yesterday at the District 1 Track and Field Championships at West Chester University's Farrell Stadium. She also won the long jump, was fourth in the 100-meter hurdles and finished far back in the triple jump.

"I like to keep busy," said Grube, who also is a swimmer, diver and gymnast for Upper Darby.

She couldn't, however, keep busy enough to put the Royals' girls' team in contention for the AAA district title. That was won by Penn Wood, which received a first-place finish from D'Angela Johnson in the 100 meters and triumphed in the 400-meter relay to finish with 62 points.

Penn Wood's margin of 14 points over second-place Truman should have been larger, but its 1,600-meter relay team was disqualified for using foul language after its victory. Cheltenham, the second-place team, was awarded the victory in the race.

West Chester Henderson was third in the standings with 43 points.

In girls' AA competition, Avon Grove compiled 108 points to take first place. The Red Devils' Tolanda Cain won the long jump and the 100 and 200 meters, and was a member of the winning 400-meter relay team.

Gwynedd-Mercy was second with 67 points, and Pottstown third with 62.

Penn Wood's Leon Howard turned in the spring's best long-jump performance in Southeastern Pennsylvania, and Todd Curll of North Penn easily won the pole vault competition, as the two-day PIAA District 1 track championships got under way at West Chester University.

Howard jumped 22 feet, 7 3/4 inches, bettering the mark of West Chester Henderson's John Hill (22-6 1/2). Hill finished second to Howard in the Class AAA long-jump competition. Curll cleared 14 feet, 6 inches to take the pole-vault title in Class AAA.

While most of the competitors and coaches at yesterday's District 1 Track and Field Championships roamed the infield or stands at West Chester University's Farrell Stadium, Bob Friday maintained a vantage point far from the finish line, sprawled on a concrete walkway behind a cyclone fence.

"I like it here," said the West Chester Henderson boys' coach. "No one bothers me. I can see the races and no one can get too close."

And on this sparkling spring afternoon, no one got too close to Friday's team either.

Getting first-place finishes from Chad Black (100, 200), Jerry Patterson (400), Matt Daniels (800), Ron Hatter (triple jump) and its 3,200-meter relay team, Henderson's boys ran away with the AAA district title.

"It was probably the best race of his life and he kept us in contention."

Daniels, who missed the indoor season because of a hernia operation, also had more than a little to do with the Warriors' success.

"I knew if I hung in there, my time would come," said Daniels, a senior.
