Hahn wins district shot put

While most of the attention at yesterday's first day of the PIAA District 1 track championships was focused on the track heats, the best finish of the day happened outside the Bensalem High stadium, at the shot put circle.

In the first boys' Class AAA final of the day, Central Bucks East's Carl Hahn and Glen Mills' Anthony Burson battled to their last attempts, with Hahn's heave of 54 feet, 7 3/4 inches beating Burson's best by just 4 1/2 inches.

"I'm happy I pulled it out," said Hahn, whose personal best of 58-1 this year is the second best in the state. "My second and third throws were way out there, but I fouled on both."

Hahn and Burson were the only shot-putters to better the state championship qualifying distance of 52-0. Hahn's best preliminary throw was 53-11, a half-inch better than Burson's best.

"I knew I had to beat him," Hahn said. "He's beaten me before this year."

Hahn will enter next weekend's PIAA state championship meet at Shippensburg University as the second seed, behind John Halli of Kiski

Area. But first, he'll try for a district double victory in the discus throw today.

No meet records were set in any events yesterday, and the person most disappointed about that was Penn Wood's Dawn Burrell, who won the girls' AAA long jump at 19-3 3/4.

"I want to hit 20 feet outdoors, and I was looking to do it here," she said. "This is a good facility."

Burrell had only two good jumps in the competition, breaking up her preliminary and final rounds with a winning qualifying race in the 300-meter hurdles. She took one jump after the race, and passed on her last two tries.

"I was too tired," she said. "I even jumped the last time in my running shoes. I really think I could have gone 20 today."

Henderson boys win again

Kennett third overall; Davis wins 100, 200

BENSALEM — Patience is something Kennett High School's Marc Davis knows a lot about.

He waited four years to win the 100-meter dash in the District 1 Class AA boys' track and field meet.

But his time finally came on Saturday at Bensalem High School.

Davis beat Pottstown's Reggie Thorpe in a photo finish as both clocked in at 11.1.

He also finished first in the 200 (22.7), and came the area's only double-winner in the individual events.

"I've been trying for four years to win the 100," said Davis, who was seeded first in the event. "I finished second the last two years, and I was hurt my freshman year.

"A state medal is my biggest goal now. I'd say I have a pretty good chance of placing up there."

In addition to qualifying for the state meet the 100 and 200, Davis also qualified as part of Kennett's 400 relay team.

Jay Bazzano, Steve Reeves, Taylor Twyman and Davis finished second, but their time of 44.1 earned them a trip to Shippensburg University.

Reeves won the 400 in 51.0 to make the state meet.

Kennett finished third in the team standings with 78 points. Pottstown was first (119) and Holy Ghost Prep second (91).

Oxford's Tim Robinson finished first in the triple jump (46-5 1/2), Garnet Valley's Brent Perechyny was first in the shot put (50-5 1/4) and Devon Prep's Jeff Todd won the 3,200 (11:13).

All three will get a shot at earning a state medal. Nobody else in the area qualified for the Class AA meet.

Kennett placed sixth or higher in 13 events, however, they couldn't match Pottstown's effort.

"We thought we had a chance (to win the team title), but we're not as deep as them

Warriors now take aim at winning state

BENSALEM — West Chester Henderson High School boys' track coach Bob Friday is afraid somebody's going to wake him up and spoil it all.

After all, this is a dream team we're talking about here.

The Henderson boys continued their remarkable success story Saturday when they repeated as team champions of the District 1 Class AAA track and field meet at Bensalem High School.

Henderson finished with 78 points to beat Glen Mills (61) and North Penn (55).

The Warriors' final quest will be to repeat as the state Class AAA team champion next weekend at Shippensburg University.

"We've been blessed," said Friday. "Henderson is not a big school, and with all the sports programs we support, getting a team of this caliber is a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity.

"We got a rare opportunity and did something with it."

Chad Black, Ron Hatter, Jason Wingard, Steve Miller, Ed Becker and Louis Blount all played major roles in Henderson's team title Saturday.

They also helped the Warriors qualify for the state meet in seven events.

Wingard won the 300 hurdles (38.1), Black the 110 hurdles (14.0) and Hatter the triple jump (47-2 1/4). They also combined with Miller to capture the 1,600 relay (3:17.9).

Also qualifying for states were Hatter in the 110 hurdles (second in 14.6), Black in the 100 (second in 10.6) and Miller in the 800 (third in 1:56.9).

"Overall, we did as well as we could," said Friday. "In the events where I thought we were serious contenders, the worse we got was second."

The only damper of the day for Henderson was a second-place finish in the 3,200 relay (8:05.5). The Warriors missed qualifying for states by five-tenths of a second.

Coatesville had two state qualifiers. James

BENSALEM — It is staggering to think how well Downingtown freshman Allison Litz will do when she's a little older and a little stronger or how well West Chester East sophomore Sara Borst will do when she's mastered the mechanics of running.

It's incomprehensible to think how well Phoenixville junior Stacey Robinson will do once she gains a little experience as a competitive runner.

The speedy Phantom, who didn't take up running until six months ago, was the only double gold medal winner at Saturday's District 1 AAA girls' track championships at Bensalem High's Stadium.

Robinson started off by running the third leg of the Phantoms' 4x800 relay. Phoenixville got a silver medal in the event with a clocking of 9:37.3.

Dawn Burrell and Adrienne Ashton accomplished personal goals, and Shane Pratt swept the boys' 100- and 200-meter dashes to highlight the second day's events at the PIAA District 1 track championships at Bensalem High School yesterday.

Burrell, a senior from Penn Wood, won four individual events and set the only meet record in winning the 300-meter hurdles. Ashton, a senior at Central Bucks East, won the girls' 400-meter run for the fourth consecutive year.

Burrell won the triple jump (36 feet, 11 3/4 inches) and 300 hurdles in the morning, then won the 100 hurdles (14.72) in the afternoon.

Combining yesterday's performance with long-jump victory on Friday, Burrell scored 40 points, helping Penn Wood retain the girls' Class AAA team title.

Ashton's Central Bucks East team placed second to Penn Wood, with Ashton's victories in the 200 and 400 netting 20 points. Her district title in the 400 was her fourth in a row.

Penn Wood's Pratt, a junior, stamped himself as a sprinter to watch when he clocked 10.40 in the 100 meters at last week's Suburban One National Conference Colonial Division championships. He won the 100 yesterday in 10.80, finishing .01 ahead of West Chester Henderson's Chad Black, and the 200 in a hand-timed 21.3.
