

Villa Maria's Brown sets long-jump record

Angie Brown had been hoping for a trophy case on her 18th birthday, which was May 15.

"That's what they told me I was getting," the Villa Maria senior said. "But I'm still waiting for it."

When and if Brown finally does get her trophy case, she'll have at least one more medal to help fill it.

In the first day of the PIAA District 1 track and field championships at Coatesville yesterday, Brown won the Class AA girls' long jump for the fourth straight year with a jump of 19 feet, 0¼ inch, breaking her own meet record of 18-10½ set last year.

The gold medal was Brown's 11th in district meet competition, and she has a chance to end her incredible career with *three* more today: in the 200- and 400-meter races and the triple jump. Plus, the Hurricanes are favored to win the AA team title.

Despite her win by more than two feet in the long jump, Brown, a perfectionist, wasn't pleased with her performance. She jumped more than 20 feet this winter in indoor track, but hasn't hit the mark this spring and wanted to hit it at districts.

Instead, Brown struggled in the preliminaries, finally went over 18 feet on her fifth jump and went 19-0¼ on her last attempt.

"I kept taking off on my right foot, which is the wrong foot," Brown explained. "That's the foot I take off with on the triple jump and I was getting my steps and approach all confused. I finally straightened it out."

"My coaches keep telling me I get down on myself, but I expect a lot from myself. I keep expecting 20 feet to come anytime now, but I only have one week left."

That last week will be at the state championship meet Friday and next Saturday at Shippensburg, where Brown will be shooting for her third straight state title in the long jump.

Glen Mills' Raymone Lacey added another gold medal to his growing collection. The senior had already won the indoor state and national titles this winter in the shot put and won the Penn Relays title in April.

Yesterday he threw 61-¾ to win the AAA shot put and top longtime rival and defending champion Scott Warren of Central Bucks West (57-7¼). Lacey also broke the meet record of 60-5¾ set by Gregory Ellis of Lansdowne-Aldan in 1965.

All running finals, plus 12 field-event finals, will be today. All win-

ners, plus any top-six finisher who meets the state qualifying standard, will advance to the state meet.
