- Team representatives and athletes may not arrive to Coatesville prior to 7:30AM
- Coaches- please monitor your athletes and make sure they remain in the competition areas; No athletes, coaches, or spectators will be permitted in either building on campus.
 - No coaches or athletes will be permitted on the infield (this area will be roped off)
 - There is a warm-up area behind the home bleachers. Do not use the infield turf for warm-ups
 - Tents are not permitted to be set up near any of our school buildings on Friday, May 21
- District Championship Meet start times: Friday & Saturday Event Start Times- 9:00AM
- All tickets are \$5.00 – tickets will go on sale at the home gate at 8:00AM
- Security will be at the entrance directing spectators where to park (no parking along curbs or on the grass) **Green Lot** – Bus Parking, **Red** and **Blue** Lot for Spectators, and the **Yellow** Lot is Reserved For Officials and CASD Personnel – specifically on Friday.
- Restrooms: 50 yard line on both sides, Throwing Events
- Concessions will be available and located at the main entrance on the home side

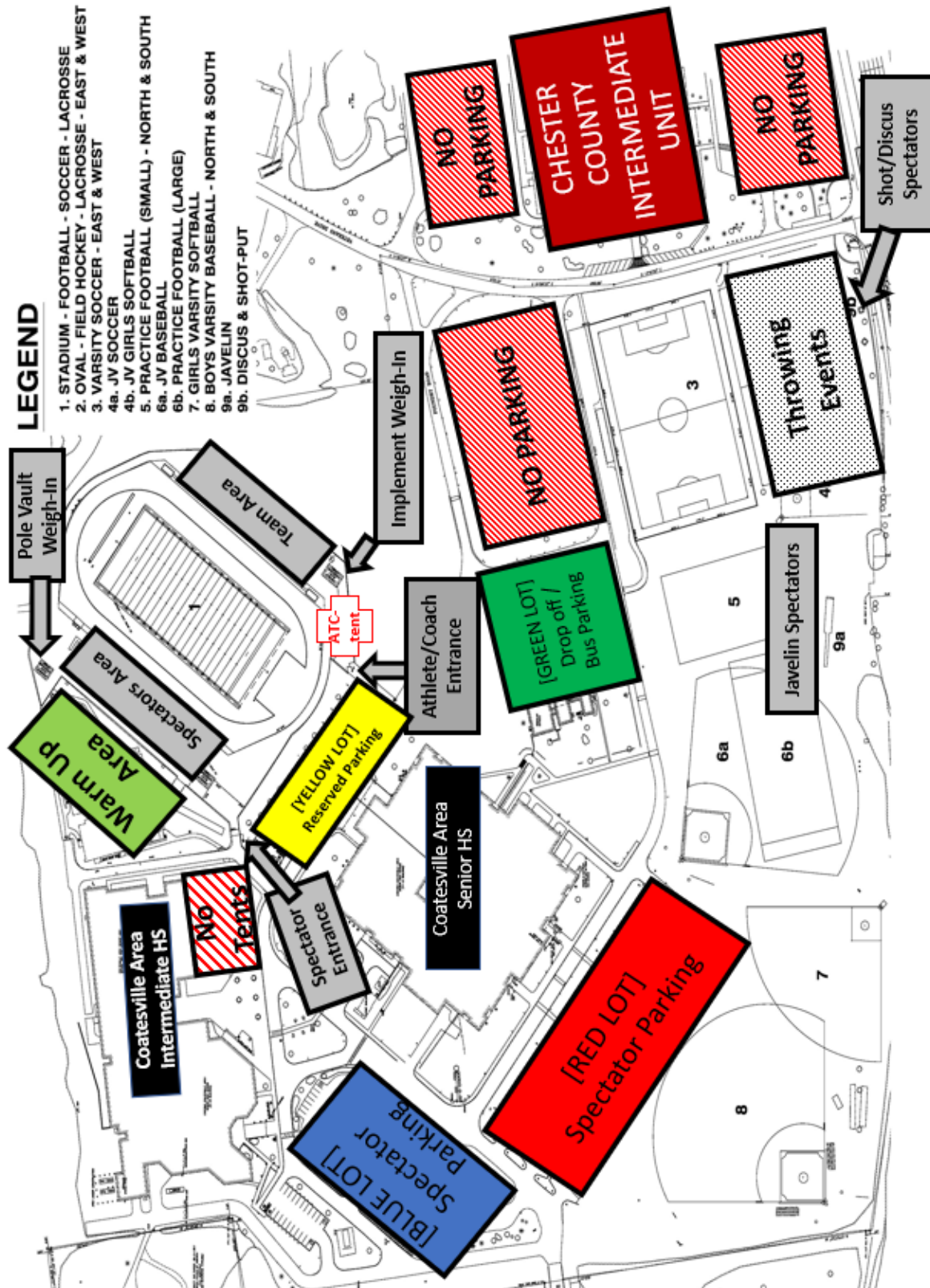
In an effort to plan accordingly for Friday May 21, our students begin school at 7:15AM and dismiss at 2:15 PM. Traffic increases significantly around our campus during these time periods. I have attached a map of our campus that outlines the parking and competition areas. Spectators, Coaches, and Student-Athletes not in competition, must wear face coverings. In an effort to prevent the spread of COVID-19, spectators are reminded to continue to use best practices, including social distancing, sanitizing/washing their hands often and to remain at home if not feeling well.

We have limited seating in the field event areas, so please encourage your fans to bring chairs. I will have personnel posted at the entrance directing spectators where to park as they enter campus. Portable restrooms are located throughout campus, at the field events competition area, as well as restroom facilities in the stadium.

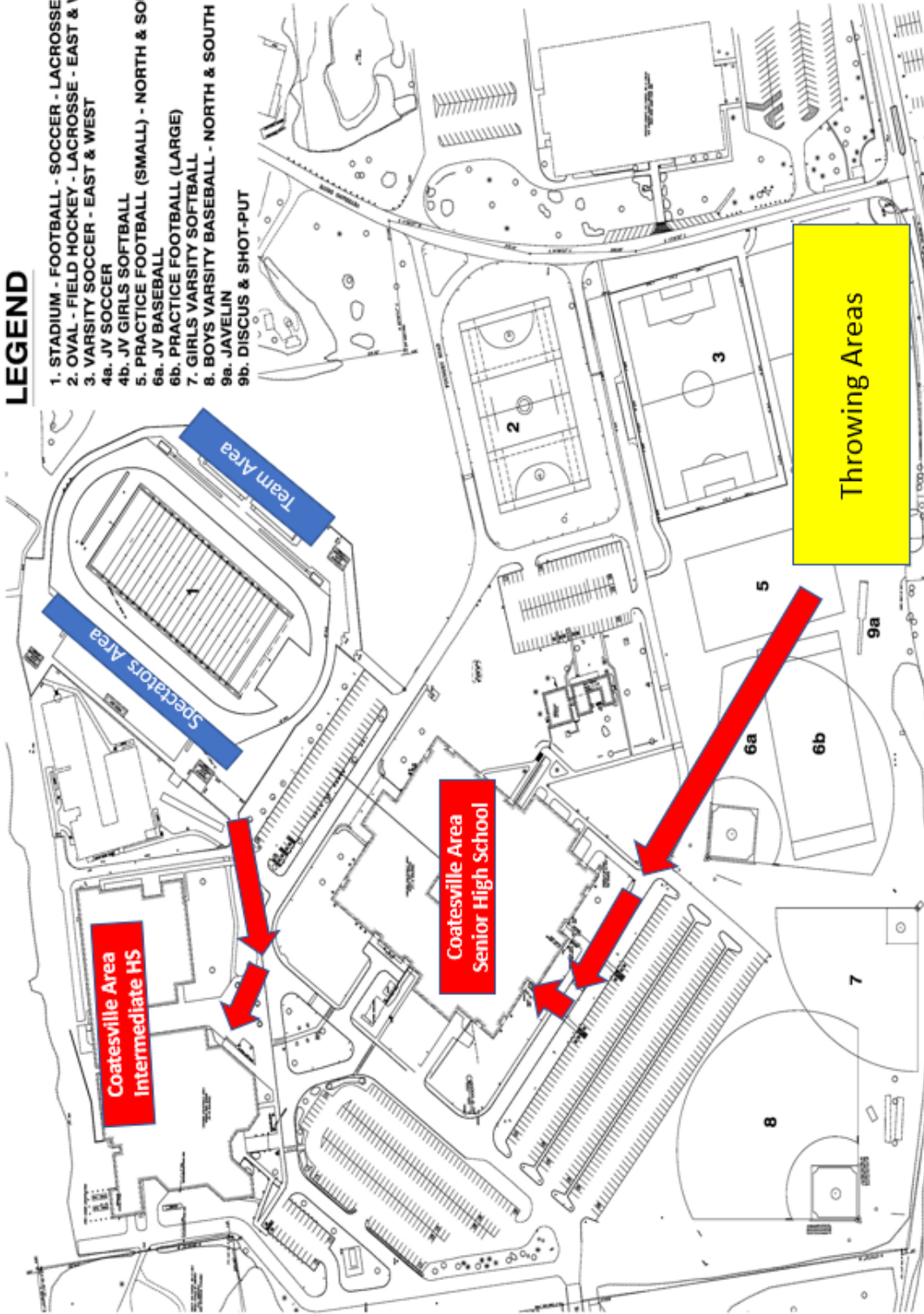
PIAA District I Track & Field Championship May 21 & 22 2021
