

District One Game Reports – Game Fees Policy (8.2022)

The approved policy from the PIAA District One Committee suggests that tickets should be sold at all contests where permitted. However, when circumstances such as fencing on fields, do not support ticket sales please check with the District One Office before you decide not to sell tickets. Tickets must be sold for all double header contests. The District Committee is seeking to enhance revenue by selling tickets at each game and control expenses by determining the number of game helpers based on estimated attendance. District One does provide a recommended maximum amount for game help expenditures as listed below. The District One Office and Sport chairpersons will work with game managers to accommodate special circumstances such as large crowds, local rivalries etc. Games with limited attendance should have reasonable personnel costs particularly for security.

District One Playoff Contests – Tickets Sold (Home Sites / Higher Seeds)

- District One will no longer use cash sales All tickets will be sold via an electronic ticket service.
- Host school will prepare the District One contest management financial forms.
- District One will pay PIAA Officials.
- Host School will process their game help payroll as if it were a regular-season contest.
- District One will reimburse the school or school district for cost of game help.
 - o District One will no longer pay individual workers for contest hosted by home teams.
- District One will pay the identified Game Manager individually and separately.
 - o Game Manager stipend is not included in the maximum game costs.
- Additional game cost must be approved by the District One Office.

District One Playoff Contests (Championship / Neutral Sites)

- District One will no longer use cash sales All tickets will be sold via an electronic ticket service.
- Host school will prepare the **PIAA contest management online financial forms**.
- District One will cover costs and game expenses of Championship / Neutral Site contests
- District One will pay PIAA Officials.
- District One will pay neutral site Game Manager, individual game workers and additional expenses.

Championship / Neutral Site Contests (No Tickets Sold)

- Host school will prepare the PIAA contest management online financial forms.
- District One will cover costs of Neutral Site contests.
- District One will pay PIAA Officials.
- District One will pay neutral site Game Manager, individual game workers and any additional expenses.

District One Playoff Contests (No Tickets Sold)

- No Game report required.
- District One will pay PIAA Officials.
- Host school will cover any additional game management costs.

Game Manager Fees

- Football Game Manager \$100
- Contest tickets are sold \$75 single game / \$125 double header
- Contest No tickets sold no fees
- Championship / Neutral Site Game Manager Fees \$100 single game / \$150 for DH

Home Playoff Contest Costs - Tickets sold.

Game Manager Fees are not included in the maximum game costs.

- VB/FH/Soccer/LAX
 - o Afternoon Home game \$ 250
 - o Afternoon Home game Double Header \$ 350
 - o Night Home game \$ 300
 - o Night Home game Double Header \$ 400
- Basketball Home game \$ 350
- Basketball Home Double Header \$500
- Neutral Site game (estimated costs approved by the District One Office)
- Football Contests Game Managers are expected to run a home football game the same as a regular season home contest. Games with limited attendance should have reasonable personnel costs particularly for police and security. Game managers are asked to contact the District One office if they anticipate extra costs for special circumstances such as large crowds, local rivalries etc.
