Executive Secretary Report

- Upon motion by Patrick Nugent/David Baun, the committee approved the appointment of Dr. Jason Sherlock as the PIAA D1 Nomination Chair to replace Dr. Nugent. **Unanimous (25 Votes)**
- Terms for the D1 Committee Advisory Committee Representatives (Female Rep. / Male/Female Parent Rep. / Private School Rep. / Middle School Rep.) will run through June 2020. Nominations for these positions will open in April and will be approved at the May District One Meeting.
- Sean Kelly presented discussion points from the Soccer Steering Committee Meeting.
 - O Review of the Playoff qualifiers for the next two year cycle. The Soccer Steering Committee is requesting to expand the 3A and 4A brackets. (3A to 12 teams / 4A to 32, 30, 28 or 26 teams.). No action was taken at the District One meeting. D1 Committee members were asked to review this with coaches in their leagues and bring a recommendation to the March Meeting.
 - Review of the Power Ranking system. Tabulators made a request to not use non-D1 playoffs contests to count towards a team's final overall record. No action was taken at the D1 Committee level.
 - Soccer Steering Committee would like District One to move forward with the recommendation to change the current PIAA soccer officiating system.
 - Review of the number of Soccer ejections in 2019. Held discussions on the potential changes to the ejection rules. Soft Red-Cards and additional penalties for foul and abusive language towards officials will be evaluated by the PIAA.
 - Soccer Committee requested an earlier start to the preseason, same as football heat week. This request was already denied at the PIAA BOD level in January.

• Sean Kelly presented a clarification of the role of Officials and ATC's in concussion protocol. Every NFHS Rule book outlines Suggested Guidelines for Management of Concussion in Sports. Officials, coaches and school personnel are encourage to review these guidelines. All contest officials need to be clear on their role to recognize the signs and symptoms of a concussion during a contest. School Administration, Coaches and the appropriate health-care professionals need to understand their roles when recognizing and treating the signs and symptoms of a concussion. Approval to return an athlete to play can only be approved by an appropriate health care professional. Schools should review their Physician Operating Protocols.

- Dr. Barber reviewed the January PIAA BOD discussion points and meeting minutes. January BOD minutes were sent to member schools and are available on the PIAA website. Next PIAA BOD Meeting will be Wednesday, March 18, 2020.
- Dr. Barber reviewed ongoing PIAA litigation.

New Business

- Radnor HS submitted a self-report concerning a basketball contest they played during the 2019-2020 season. The contest was not played under PIAA and NHFS rules. Upon motion by Ed Kloss/Steve Brandt, the committee accepted the Self-Report. Unanimous (24 Votes)
- The committee held discussions on the merit of establishing minimum number of contests that must be played for sports utilizing the point system for playoff seeding consideration. Representatives are asked to seek input from their leagues for the sports of basketball, soccer, field hockey, softball and lacrosse. Schools who do not play the minimum number of contests will have those missing contests count towards the power rankings. A proposal will be brought forward at the March meeting.

New Business (cont.)

- League representatives are asked to seek input from leagues in reference to D1
 Golf Championships to charging Greens Fee for each golfer that competes in
 the District Championships. D1 Office will contact surrounding PIAA
 Districts to review their policies.
- District One Office received a report that the Girard College High School Basketball team used an ineligible player during the 2019-2020 season. As a result, Girard College High School was required to forfeit all games for which the ineligible player participated. Girard College has been asked to submit a self-report to the District One Committee for review at the March meeting.
- Committee members are asked to review the proposed D1 and PIAA playoff Qualifiers and Classifications for next 2 year cycle 2020-2021/2021-2022. Special attention should be given to the B/G 3A and 4A Soccer qualifiers. A proposal for approval should be brought forward at the March Meeting.
