

2024 PIAA TRACK & FIELD CHAMPIONSHIPS

Each PIAA District that sponsors a qualifying meet shall be entitled to a minimum number of entries, per track and field event, per enrollment classification, to the PIAA Track and Field Championships. In addition, individuals or relay Teams that place eighth (8th) or better in the finals of a District qualifying meet shall also qualify to the track and field championships provided their District qualifying meet time, height or distance is equal to or better than the qualifying time, height or distance stated below:

MEDALS STANDARDS

Consistent with PIAA's goal of expanding competitive opportunities for students with disabilities, Para Ambulatory Athletes and Wheelchair Athletes will have an opportunity to earn individual awards at the PIAA Championship Meet. For each event in which two or more Para Ambulatory Athletes or Wheelchair Athletes compete, gold, silver, and bronze medals will be presented to the top finishers based on place, time and distance consistent with any other event in which students without disabilities compete. If two Para Ambulatory Athletes or Wheelchair Athletes compete in a single event, then finishers will earn individual awards based upon their finish of place, time or distance.
